Abstract

This research is based on Organizational Behavior Theory. The purpose of this study was to build an understanding of the effect of job placement on employee performance, the effect of job training on employee performance, moderation of spiritual motivation on job placement and employee performance, moderation of spiritual motivation on job training on employee performance. Type of research is Explanatory Research, Data collection using a questionnaire. The sampling technique used accidental sampling. The number of samples was 322 Employees of Anchovy Export Company on Madura Island, East Java, Indonesia, and data analysis used the SEM-PLS. The results of this study indicate that Job placement has a significant effect on employee performance, Job training has a significant effect on employee performance, Spiritual motivation moderates Job placement on employee performance, and Spiritual motivation moderates job training on employee performance.

Google Scholar is a freely accessible web search engine that indexes the full text or metadata of scholarly literature across an array of publishing formats and disciplines. Released in beta in November 2004, the Google Scholar index includes most peer-reviewed online academic journals and books, conference papers, theses and dissertations, preprints, abstracts, technical reports, and other scholarly literature, including court opinions and patents. While Google does not publish the size of Google Scholar's database, scientometric researchers estimated it to contain roughly 389 million documents including articles, citations and patents making it the world's largest academic search engine in January 2018. Previously, the size was estimated at 160 million documents as of May 2014.



Crossref (formerly styled CrossRef) is an official digital object identifier (DOI) Registration Agency of the International DOI Foundation. It is run by the Publishers International Linking Association Inc. (PILA) and was launched in early 2000 as a cooperative effort among publishers to enable persistent cross-publisher citation linking in online academic journals. Crossref is a not-for-profit association of about 2,000 voting member publishers who represent 4,300 societies and publishers, including both commercial and not-for-profit organizations.



An International Standard Serial Number (ISSN) is an eight-digit serial number used to uniquely identify a serial publication, such as a magazine. The ISSN is especially helpful in distinguishing between serials with the same title. ISSNs is used in ordering, cataloging, interlibrary loans, and other practices in connection with serial literature.
